This offer will be accepted once FNBO receives and processes payment of at least a portion of Payment One by its due date. However, FNBO must receive the full amount of both Payments One, Two, and Three by their due dates (equal to the Total Settlement Amount) to complete the settlement. Once FNBO receives and processes payment of the Total Settlement Amount, any remaining account balance will be canceled. FNBO will then report the account as settled to the credit bureaus.

If FNBO receives only part of Payments One, Two and /or Three, or if any payment is late, the cardmember will receive credit for any payment(s), but no debt will be canceled and FNBO may report the account to the credit bureaus as charged-off at that time.

Include the cardmember's name and the account number on all checks to ensure proper credit. No credit will be given for dishonored payments or returned checks.

Please note, if \$600.00 or more of an account's balance is canceled, federal law requires FNBO to report the amount as canceled debt to the Internal Revenue Service and issue a Form 1099-C. FNBO issues and mails 1099-C forms every January for the prior year. Any tax questions should be directed to a Certified Public Accountant or other qualified tax professional.
